Creating PDF files

Illustrator

Under file menu choose "Save As"

- Select "Format" and choose Adobe PDF (pdf)
- under Adobe PDF Preset choose [PDF/X:4-2008]
- then select Marks & Bleeds (in the left hand column) - [1] select "Trim Marks"
 - in the "Bleeds" section insert 3mm & have the chain linked this will give you uniform bleed on all edges*



Indesign

Under file menu choose "Export" - Select "Format" and choose Adobe PDF (Print)

- under Adobe PDF Preset choose [PDF/X:4-2008]
- then select Marks & Bleeds (in the left hand column) - [**/**] select "Crop Marks"
 - in the "Bleed and Slug" section insert 3mm & have the chain linked this will give you uniform bleed on all edges*

* when creating your document, you must have the graphic extending over the artboard by at least 3mm for this to take affect
